

## THE FOLKLORE FORUM PRIZE

The editors of the FOLKLORE FORUM are pleased to announce that Leo LaSota, an I.U. doctoral candidate, has donated funds to establish an award competition for essays and short monographs in folklore. Submissions must be unpublished manuscripts. The winning entry or entries will be published in the FORUM, or, if warranted, as a number of the Bibliographic and Special Series.

There is no limitation placed on the type of material eligible; the term "folklore" will be interpreted as broadly as possible. The editors are particularly interested in seeing articles which posit new theoretical or methodological approaches or attempt new applications of current folklore theory. This is not to discourage, however, other types of studies, short indexes, handbooks, etc.

The award for 1969 will amount to \$25.00. The editors reserve the right to award a second prize, if called for, or to award no prize, in the event that the quality of material submitted does not merit one. Non-award winning submissions remain eligible for publication in the FORUM, at the discretion of the editors, but these articles remain the property of the individual authors, who may withdraw them from further consideration.

Entries should be typewritten, double-spaced and submitted in duplicate (ribbon copy and carbon). Notations, bibliography and general style should be generally consistent with one or another of the style manuals in common use. Length should be 1,500 to 20,000 words. Photographs, diagrams and other illustrations should be kept to a minimum. A stamped, self-addressed envelope should be enclosed, if return of manuscript is desired. There should be a separate title and author page and the author's name should appear only on that page. Mailing envelopes should be marked "Competition" and mailed to:
