MANUSCRIPTS: *Folklore Forum* publishes interdisciplinary articles on any aspect of folklore or folklife. Manuscripts which are based upon ethnographic fieldwork are especially encouraged. Articles submitted for publication should not exceed thirty double-spaced pages in length. Photographs are encouraged in articles dealing with material culture. All submissions should be made in duplicate and should include return postage. All submissions should conform to the **American Folklore Society Style Guide** (*Journal of American Folklore* vol. 101, no. 400, 1988). Since manuscripts are refereed anonymously, the author's name should appear along with brief contributor information (not exceeding fifty words) on the *title page only*.

Book Reviews, Topics and Comments, and Translations of significant foreign articles are also encouraged. Open Forum functions as an arena for informal dialogue about issues within the discipline. Short, provocative, controversial essays will be published in this section. The editors will normally solicit responses to these essays in order to provide alternative perspectives.

Submissions should include electronic manuscript in either IBM or Macintosh formatted floppy diskette accompanying the hard copy when possible.
