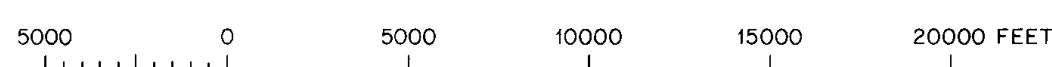
Total well completions within Huntington County exceed those shown on this map; specific locations for some wells drilled many years ago cannot be determined. Although this map is known to be incomplete, all well locations have been verified by field investigation or from various property plat maps showing well locations.

Note: Reserves are recognized land divisions defined prior to surveys establishing the congressional system. For convenience in description they are assigned to congressional townships; the arbitrary township boundaries are shaded.
