One day, a **lion** asked his wife to go hunting because he was hungry.

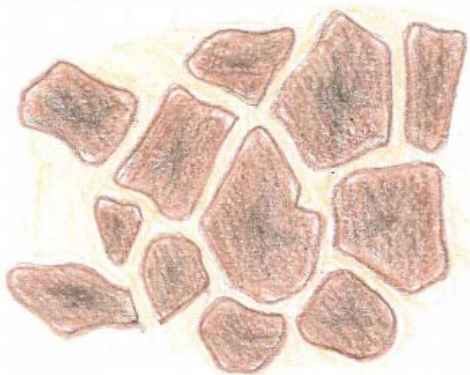


She went out hunting and caught an elephant.

His wife went back. This time, she caught a giraffe. She said to him, “I hope you like this food. It was hard to catch.”

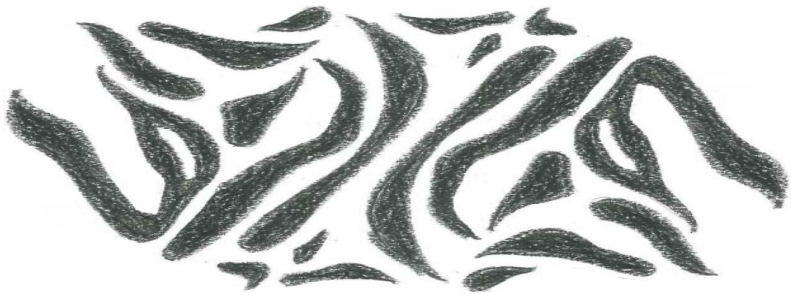


“No,” he said. “I am hungry. Bring me something bigger.”

“No,” he said. “These are all too **small**. Bring me something bigger!”



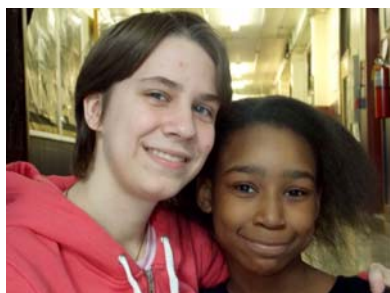
Now it was **dark**. All the animals were asleep. But his wife still went back. She caught a tiny **rabbit**.
