

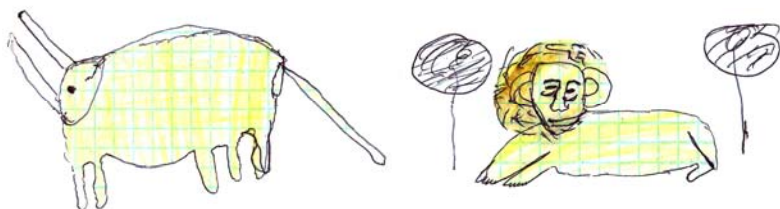
Let Us Take Care of the Environment

- What can you do to protect the environment?

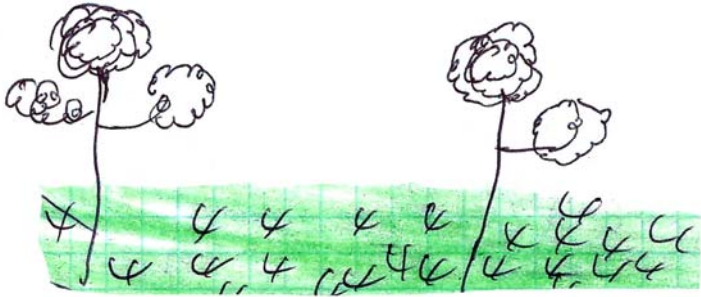
My friends and I went to visit **Akagera National Park**. We saw lions, elephants, and other animals. When we became bored, my friends told me that they were hungry and we went to eat.
