In 1977 a special project was started by the Indiana Historical Society to record books and other materials on Indiana history. These special recordings are for the blind and physically handicapped who are unable to read regular print books. Volunteers are helping to produce these books and other materials on tape. Titles for recording have been selected from: *Indiana Historical Society Publications*, the *Indiana Magazine of History*, *Indiana Historical Bureau Collections*, books by Indiana authors, and other books and articles on Indiana history. Recordings are available to all eligible patrons of the Division for the Blind and Physically Handicapped.
