

Back Numbers

Will Buy, Sell, or Trade

Because libraries and individuals are sometimes anxious to complete their files of the *Indiana Magazine of History*, the following offer is made:

\$1.50 per number or \$6.00 per volume will be paid for numbers of the first eight volumes (1905-1912), and for No. 1 of Vol. X (1914), Nos. 3 and 4 of Vol. XVII (1921), and Nos. 1, 3 and 4 of Vol. XVIII (1922).

\$1.00 per number or \$4.00 per volume will be paid for the numbers of Volumes IX through XV (1913-1919).

Beginning with Volume XVI (1920), the supply of back numbers is fairly adequate except as noted above. Some of these later numbers will be bought for 50 cents or for \$2.00 per volume.

Such numbers as are now available or may become available will be sold at the above prices. Numbers will be traded for other numbers so that subscribers can complete certain volumes. These transactions are made for the accommodation of subscribers, and profit does not accrue to the *Magazine* or to any person or organization. Subscribers who wish to dispose of recent back numbers which do not now have a monetary value are urged not to destroy their copies. Postage or express will be paid if you will send any back numbers to the *Indiana Magazine of History*, Indiana University, Bloomington, Indiana.
