## Review Notices

Mimeographed copies of four bulletins concerning the postal history of Evansville and Southwestern Indiana have been received. Number 1 was published in February, 1948; Number 2 in August, 1948; Number 3 in August, 1949; and Number 4 in May, 1956. All appeared under the auspices of the Evansville Stamp Club, Department of Philately, Evansville Public Museum. These bulletins include information and frequent reproductions of receiving marks, sending marks, route marks, and detailed data regarding the locations and durations of post offices in the eight counties of Dubois, Gibson, Perry, Pike, Posey, Spencer, Vanderburgh, and Warrick.

Copies of the preliminary inventories concerning certain federal records have also been received. Number 93 entitled "Records of the Federal Communications Commission (Record Group 173)" was compiled by Albert W.
