

Henry F. Schricker Library

During 1966, with former Governor and Mrs. Henry F. Schricker in attendance, the Edgewood High School Library at Ellettsville was dedicated as the Henry F. Schricker Library. In naming this school library after Governor Schricker, Ellettsville citizens gave merited recognition to the only Hoosier who has served two full terms as governor since the Constitution of 1851 was adopted. They also indicated their affection for and appreciation of the many visits and long-time participation of the Schrickers in Ellettsville's annual fall festival.

The librarian of the Henry F. Schricker Library, Miss Frances Harding, is eager to develop and preserve a collection of books, pamphlets, magazines, and the like concerning Indiana history from the early days to the present. Individuals having items which they are willing to donate to such a collection should write Miss Harding and indicate the type of material available for possible library acquisition. She is particularly eager to complete the library's file of the *Indiana Magazine of History*. For this purpose copies of volumes 3, 31-35, 37-39, 41, 47-57 are needed.
