## **The Société Rencesvals**

The Société Internationale Rencesvals is an organization of scholars devoted to the study of medieval epic literature in the various Romance languages. Membership in the Société and its national or regional branches is open to all persons interested in the medieval Romance epic, its cognates, and derivatives. The organization's main activities are organizing international congresses and branch meetings, sponsoring sessions at major conferences throughout its membership areas, and the publication of an annual critical *Bulletin bibliographique*, including notices of book reviews in learned journals. Since 1958, the society has met triennially at a variety of world locales for the purposes of hearing papers related to the epic and facilitating discussion among medievalists. The American-Canadian branch meets regularly each May in conjunction with the International Congress on Medieval Studies at Western Michigan University and sponsors sessions each December at the annual convention of the Modern Language Association.
